

Application Deadline: June 26, 2017

Leadership Harrisburg Area is a non-profit organization serving Cumberland, Dauphin and Perry Counties with leadership development and community leadership programs. Leadership Harrisburg Area, LHA, was established in 1986 with a mission that is still as strong today: To engage, develop and mobilize a diverse group of skilled leaders to shape our region's future, strengthen our communities and enhance the organization's they serve.

LHA's core program is the Community Leadership Series - a 9-month exploration of Central PA focusing on the region's strengths, opportunities and resources. Each class member in LHA's Community Leadership Series (CLS) participates in a Team Project serving a non-profit organization. Service to the non-profit organization is above and beyond the 100-hour series commitment.

Leadership Harrisburg Area added the Team Project component to its Community Leadership Series in 2003 and has served over 63 organizations since with critical assistance in the areas of strategic planning; marketing; feasibility studies; market surveys & research; management planning; emergency planning; and much, much more. The goals of the Team Projects are for CLS Participants to:

1. Experience the inner-workings of a non-profit organization and demonstrate a deep and clear understanding of the issues and challenges faced by local groups.
2. Experience the realities of working toward a common goal with a team of volunteers.
3. Serve the Capital Region by providing feedback, advice, skills, resources and a mutually agreed upon deliverable to a non-profit organization.

If your organization has a project that meets the following criteria, we encourage you to apply.

1. The project has a meaningful goal that will impact the organization and/or the community and can be achieved within a 9-month time frame (September-May).
2. The project has a single point of contact within your organization that can provide the background, materials and support needed for the team members to succeed.
3. The project has met with approval from your organization's board of directors.
4. The project will not require any funds on the part of LHA or the team members.
5. The project does NOT expect or ask LHA or team members to raise funds.
6. Agency or organization is a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, church or school.
7. Agency or organization is located in or serving Cumberland, Dauphin or Perry Counties.
8. The single point of contact is available to make a 15-minute presentation to LHA in August 2017 (TBD).
9. If selected, the single point of contact is available to discuss the project with the Class of 2018 on Saturday, September 8, 2017.
10. If selected, the single point of contact is available to meet with the class during their session on Wednesday, October 4, 2017, in Harrisburg.
11. If the results are made public, your organization will acknowledge LHA in promotions and announcements.

General Team Project Timeline:

July - August	Finalist organizations will be invited to an interview. Winners will be notified.
September 9	Selected organizations will attend the CLS Opening Retreat to describe and promote their project to the class.
October 4	Selected organizations will attend the CLS Session and meet their team members for the first time. Group will finalize methods of communication, meet Team Project Mentor, Identify Team Project Leader and establish the next meeting date.
Oct. - Dec.	Team members begin information gathering, tour facilities, collect data, assign tasks, establish project framework, etc.
Dec. - Feb.	Teams begin piecing the information together, analyzing findings, drafting plans and considering recommendations.
Feb. - May	Teams organize findings, finalize drafts and recommendations.
May	Teams present findings to Leadership Harrisburg Area and, at a separately agreed upon date and time, to the Non-Profit Organization.
